



The Kittitas County Water Purveyors (KCWP) and the Department of Ecology have money available to assist landowners with purchase and installation of fencing and riparian zone revegetation projects. Assistance may also become available for design and installation of settling ponds and/or other projects that will help decrease sediment levels in streams or other waterways.

If you are interested, please submit your proposal to the KCWP. The plan should include a brief description, cost estimates associated with each stage of the project, and the amount of time/money you will contribute to the project. A form is provided on the back of this letter to help landowners with their proposal, but is not required for submitting a plan.

The fine print: landowners receiving assistance will need to sign a letter of agreement stating that the KCWP and/or the Department of Ecology can have access to the project at least once a year (at the landowners convenience) to ensure the project is being maintained and having a positive effect on water quality.
